 - Meet regularly with children, learn about their interests

 and challenges and advocate
- for them to receive services & supports.
- Navigate resources and facilitate connections for families.
- Provide peer support and advocacy for whole families.

THE FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PROGRAM

The Family Engagement Program utilizes trained and committed community volunteers to work one-on-one with a family whose children are chronically absent from school. They partner with families to identify and build upon their strengths, and provide peer support and resource navigation for families to access wraparound community supports.

It is a new, voluntary, program for families and operates entirely outside of the child welfare and court system. Family Engagement Advocates support students' needs in order to help get them reengaged in school.


WHY CASA
